About the Speakers



Carlos A. Lopez, MD, MPH, is an assistant professor in the Department of Hematology and Medical Oncology at Emory University School of Medicine. He sees patients at the Georgia Cancer Center for Excellence at Grady Memorial Hospital and at the Winship Cancer Institute at Emory Midtown. Dr. Lopez specializes in treating patients with lymphoma, chronic lymphocytic leukemia, hairy cell leukemia, and other hematologic malignancies. He is dedicated to expanding access to clinical trials for patients with lymphoma and chronic lymphocytic leukemia.

In addition to caring for patients with blood cancers, he also leads a dedicated survivorship clinic for patients of all tumor types, focusing on long-term follow-up after anti-neoplastic treatments.

Dr. Lopez earned his medical degree and Master of Public Health from the University of Pittsburgh. He completed his residency in internal medicine and fellowship in hematology and medical oncology at Northwell Health in New York, where he served as chief fellow in his final year. He also completed a pediatric cancer survivorship fellowship at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, caring for both pediatric and adult survivors of childhood cancers. He is an active member of the American Society of Hematology, the American Society of Clinical Oncology, and the American College of Physicians.
